Our Slow Fashion Philosophy

At Meyadey, we are fully committed to the **Slow Fashion Philosophy**. We are devoted to being a constant work-in-process in order to keep learning and making the best decisions for our planet.

Rethinking Seasons and Collections.

We are aiming to move away from regular seasons and collections and make it our mission to raise more awareness around the wider topic of Climate Change. This is done both through our print designs as well as our partnership with the Swedish NGO Milkywire. Overall, you can expect a total of 24 print designs per year, with one delivery containing six prints.

Creating a Slow and Sustainable Basic Range.

We do not follow trends nor do we aim to create new items on a constant basis. We believe in what we design. So much so, that we are not planning on making any big changes to our basic range in the upcoming years, apart from possible small tweaks and updates.

Focusing on fair and made-to-order Production.

Our production is the heart of it all. On one hand, as a GOTS certified brand, you can be assured that our factory in India is working under fair and decent working conditions and are paid fair wages. On the other hand, we only produce what you order in an effort to reduce waste as much as possible.

Primary Logo

Our primary logo is our horizontal logo. Is it to be used either in white (#FFFFFF) or black (#000000).

Shapes

At Meyadey, we work a lot with our shape to place titles and texts and make them more legible.

The shape has a sharp corner in the top right and bottom left paired with a rounded corner in the top left and bottom right. All four sides are straight.

The size of the shape itself can be adjusted as needed. The amount of roundness, however, depends on the width and height of the shape.

Please refer to the examples and sample shapes provided.

We can use each type of shape on its own. However, when we decide to pair them, we want to overlap the title shape over the text shape.



TYPOGRAPHY

Primary Font

Nunito Regular is our primary and official brand font. If we have a graphic or anything that only shows one font, it will be in Nunito.

Title Font

For any titles, mostly in combination with our title shape, we will use Open Sans SemiBold.

Subtitle Font

For subtitles and any highlights (e.g. if you want to put something in bold within the body text), we will use Open Sans Bold.

Accent Font

Lastly, for any accents we might want to set we are using Open Sans Light. However, please use sparingly.

In the direct communication with our consumers, we want to use a slightly more engaging and friendlier tone of voice. The focus here is on fostering a community. This shall be contrasted with the more serious matters and facts which shall be stated and elaborated in a more consumer-friendly way. The Meyadey community shall be addressed as changemakers.

Marvellous Macaw.

Birds of a feather flock together. Many of these brilliantly coloured and long-tailed parrots call the luscious Amazon Rainforest their home. But with their home slowly disappearing, the existence of these gorgeous and intelligent birds are put at risk with every passing day.

Sleepy Sloth.

These gentle and slow movers have incredible adaptability skills and call the Amazonian tree-top canopy their home. Needless to say, the loss of their habitat is highly threatening to their existence.

Tropical Orchid.

Lurking beneath the leafy canopy is the most fascinating and stunning flora to be found. Including the Amazon Orchids, which come in different sizes, colours and shapes. A diversity that is critical to preserve.

Jaguar Journey.

Enigmatic and wild, characterised by a gorgeous tawny coat dotted with dark rosettes. The jaguar is the largest cat of the Americas and is classed as near threatened with an estimated 170.000 animals remaining.

Humorous Howler.

With a tail that is up to five times as long as their body and a load howl that can be heard from miles away, this tropical New World monkey really has made a name for itself. They are constantly threatened by habitat loss and human poaching.

Savanna Woodland.

Scattered trees creating an open canopy that allows enough light to come through to support the growth of grass. These unique conditions have brought forward an incredible ecosystem and with it, rich and diverse flora and fauna and wildlife that have truly stood the test of time by acquiring impeccable adaptation skills. But now, it is human-induced climate change that is challenging and threatening the existence of this ecosystem.

Elephant Clan.

With their trunks and tusks and large ears, elephants are easily recognisable all around the world. However, the list of threats endangering the world's largest land animals is far from small. From ivory trade and poaching to habitat loss, this once very common species is slowly diminishing.

Roaming Rhino.

Successfully brought back from the brink of extinction, it is due to tireless conservation efforts and a ban on rhino horn trade that the population of rhinos is reaching stability again. Yet, poaching is still a constant threat to these grazing animals who have shaped the African landscape for millions of years.

Lion Legacy.

Majestic and powerful, this big cat is said to have no natural predators. Nonetheless, the population of lions is declining due to illegal wildlife trade and conflict as well as habitat loss and fragmentation. With currently only an estimated 23.000 lions left in the wild, this species is considered vulnerable.

These African equines are instantly recognised by their black-and-white striped coats that are as unique as fingerprints. Unfortunately, this species is classified as endangered.

Monarch Majesty.

This majestic milkweed butterfly is known for migrating thousands of miles in its lifetime However, its migration patterns and habitats are critically affected by climate change.
